- 2. The total Annual Family Income (from all sources) of the student's family should not exceed Rs. 10.00 Lakhs.
- 3. The continuation of the scholarship in a subsequent semester shall be subject to a minimum 6.5 CPI in the End Semester Examination of the previous semester, besides fulfillment of other norms, e.g., regular attendance, disciplined and exemplary behavior.
- 4. A student shall not be eligible for his/her scholarship in the next semester/s if he/she fails to satisfy any specified criteria; in such case/s, there shall not be any replacement of the student/s for the scholarship.

c) Special Merit Scholarships:

(those students who have received institute scholarship (Merit and MCM) they are not eligible for the Special Merit scholarship)
- 2. The continuation of the scholarship in the subsequent semester shall be subject to a minimum 6.5 CPI in the End Semester Examination of the previous semester.

Note:

- . No scholarships are applicable to admissions on TFW seats.
- ii. The grant of any scholarship is subject to the condition that the candidate does not receive any financial assistance in the form of fee waiver, scholarship, any payments, salary, stipend, etc., from any other source(s) during his/her course of study at the University.

3 M.Tech. Programme

The University offers financial assistance from its own resources as a Scholarship which is as follows:

- For candidates having qualified and valid GATE score and admitted in Phase-I only:
 - Rs.12,400/- per month
- ii) For candidates admitted under Phase-II Non-GATE category admission process:
 - Rs.8,000/- per month, subject to the conditions that;
 - i. The number of such candidates-beneficiaries will be limited to the number of GATE category seats in the respective branch if remain unfilled/vacant.
 - ii. The selection of candidates for the scholarships will be as per the admissionmerit, and further such candidates should have secured minimum 50% score overall for the parameters considered for the admission merit.

Total 9 no. of scholarships combining above mentioned A & B, would be available in each discipline of M.Tech having intake of 18 seats and 18 no. of scholarships for program(s) having intake of 36 seats.

iii) Other Conditions:

- i. To become eligible for the continuance of any one of above mentioned financial assistance, the respective candidate is required (1) To have earned minimum CPI of 6.5 in every semesters. (2) To have passed every semester examinations at the first attempt besides regular attendance, disciplined and exemplary behavior and compliance with other norms, as prescribed by the University from time to time.
- ii. The grant of the scholarship is subject to the condition that the candidate does not receive any financial assistance in the form of fee waiver, scholarship, any emoluments, salary, stipend etc. from any other source(s) during his/her course of study at the University.
- iii. No scholarship will be given to the candidate who passes the GATE examination after securing the admission.
- iv. The Scholarship will be granted to the candidate on a monthly basis subject to the satisfactory academic performance and adherence to the University / Institute norms / rules and regulations as applicable from time to time, certified by the Head of the Department / School Director / Dean and obligatory work as mentioned.

- v. Foreign candidates and/or sponsored candidates are not eligible for the Scholarship.
- vi. The candidate shall be required to give an undertaking to the effect that he / she would not leave the program midway. In case any candidate leaves the course in midway he / she will be required to refund the total scholarship drawn so far, at the time of leaving the program.
- vii. The Scholarship may be discontinued at any time for any kind of misconduct by the candidate, like involving in the act of ragging, misbehavior etc.
- viii. The scholarship can continue in the second year of the study not beyond the dissertation submission.
- ix. It will be obligatory on the part of every post graduate candidate to undertake 8 to 10 hours (per week) of work related to academic & co-academic and research activities as assigned to him/her from time to time. This includes tutorials, laboratory classes, development and maintenance of laboratories, assistance in research and activities undertaken by faculty members, maintenance and operation of computer and other central facilities, assistance in library, examinations, etc.

iv) Scholarship for Defence / CAPF Persons

A candidate will apply in normal category as well as in Defence/CAPF category. There would be no change in the eligibility criteria for admission as described in section-3 of this document.

- 100% tuition fee waiver to wards of Gallantry Award winner or those who
 made supreme sacrifice for the nation i.e. fatal battle causality. Candidate
 has to present proof of award from respective organization.
- 50% tuition fee waiver to the ward of war injured / war disabled soldier of defence force and CAPF. Candidate has to present war disability certificate from respective organization.
- 50% tuition fee waiver to the wards soldiers whose annual income less than
 8.0 lakhs. Candidate has to present income certificate.
- 50% tuition fee waiver to the soldiers taking admission in M.Tech. Program.

NOTE: A list of eligible candidates for Financial Assistance will be declared after the completion of the entire admission process of both ACPC and the University.

4 M.B.A. Programme

a) Merit-cum-Means Scholarships (50% Tuition Fee waiver)

- 1. The Merit cum means scholarship is available as per university scholarship policy for M.B.A. Students.
- 2. Maximum 05 Merit-cum-Means Scholarships (50% Tuition Fee waiver) are available as per PDEU scholarship policy for School of Management. The policy stipulates that family income (from all sources) of the candidate in the previous financial year should not exceed INR 10 Lakhs. Also, to be

considered for the scholarship process, the candidate should have scored a minimum 85 percentile in CAT/XAT/NMAT applicable for admissions for the session 2025-26. Other details shall be shared with candidates during the admission process.

3. Merit cum Means scholarship will be available for both the years of study.

b) Merit Scholarships (50% Tuition Fees Waiver)

- 1. The Merit scholarship is available as per university scholarship policy for M.B.A. Students as per merit.
- 2. There are total of 05 Merit scholarship available. These are pure merit scholarships without any maximum annual income criterion of parents/family. To be eligible for the scholarship, the students are required to fulfill the following criteria:
- 3. CAT/XAT/NMAT percentile score should be 85 and above. Five meritorious selected applicants, as per these scores, who are admitted to the MBA Programme (batch 2025-27) after fulfilling all admission eligibility criteria shall be the recipients of this scholarship.
- 4. Merit cum Means scholarship will be available for both the years of study.
- 5. Eligible students are required to attend classes actively & regularly, should follow School & University discipline norms, and show exemplary behavior during the MBA Programme. If selected and admitted to SoM-PDEU MBA 2025-27 batch, applicants may be eligible to be considered for the Merit Scholarships. The final decision about the four scholarship recipients shall be made purely on merit.

c) Special Appreciation Certificate for All India rank holders at the time of Induction

1. A Special Certificate of Appreciation will be given to All India rank holders.

5 Five-Year Integrated M. Sc. Physics/Chemistry/ Data Science)

- 1. A 100% tuition fee waiver will be offered to the first two students in the merit prepared with 75% of theory marks and 25% of PI (as mentioned in the section 6) for each program i.e. Physics/Chemistry/Data Science. Students must have scored 85% in class 12 in respective board examinations will be eligible for the scholarship award.
- **2.** The scholarship will be applicable only after the submission of the 12th standard board marks.

Note:

To become eligible for continuation of the scholarship in the subsequent semesters, the students are required:

i) To have earned minimum CPI of 7.5 in first and every subsequent semester,

ii) To have passed every semester examination at the first attempt besides regular attendance, disciplined and exemplary behaviour and compliance with all other norms as prescribed by the University from time to time.

Failing the above conditions, the fee waiver will be discontinued.

6 M.Sc. Programme (Physics and Chemistry)

Research based Assistantship:

Research-based Assistantship of Rs. 25,000/- per semester will be awarded to the students fulfilling the following criteria:

- 1. The student has to maintain CPI of 6.5 or above in each semester without any backlogs.
- 2. The student must meet attendance criteria set by the University.
- 3. No disciplinary action should have been taken against the student.
- 4. Failing the above conditions, the research assistantship will be discontinued.

7 B.A/ B.B.A (Hons.) and B.Com (Hons.) Programme

- 1. Merit cum means (No of scholarship 20): Half tuition fees waiver for students Eligibility criteria: Based on SLS admission test merit rank and subject to minimum 80% marks obtained in 12th board examination and family income not more than 10 Lakh per annum in the previous financial year.
 - The same student would carry the scholarship in succeeding semesters if the SPI/CPI does not go below 8/10 and the student does not have any backlog or disciplinary actions on her/him.
- 2. Merit Scholarship (No of scholarship 20): Half tuition fees waiver for students Eligibility criteria: Based on SLS admission test merit rank and subject to minimum 80% marks obtained in 12th board examination.
 - The same student would be eligible for scholarship based on his/her SPI in succeeding semesters and also the student should not have any backlog or disciplinary actions taken on her/him.
- 3. Sports Scholarship (No of scholarship 3) 40% of tuition fee waiver for students
 - Eligibility criteria: Based on an excellent track record in sports at the national/international level at the entry point, duly validated with documents of achievements and then in the succeeding semester minimum participation in 3 National/international competitions.
 - *Earn while you Learn (No of scholarship 8) This entails the scholarship to students to intern with the school in assisting documentation/data collection/admission. Selection every semester would be area wise, independent and based on the academic records of the students.
- 4. Defense/CAFP Quota In order to honour the sacrifices made by our Defense

persons/ CAPF towards our nation, respect the fallen heroes and also serve as a means of support for their families, following scholarship is proposed:

- a. 100% waiver of tuition fees to wards of Gallantry Award winner or those who made supreme sacrifice for the nation i.e. fatal battle causality on providing a proof of award from respective organization
- b. 50% waiver of tuition fees to wards of war injured / war disabled soldiers of Defense forces and CAFP on providing a war injury / disability certificate from respective medical organization
- c. 50% waiver of tuition fees to wards of soldiers whose annual income is less than 8 lakhs on providing an income certificate

Scholarship benefits will be passed on to those students only who has not applied for/received any other scholarship assistance under any other state/central government scheme. No action has been taken against serious mischief in accordance with the policy rules or moral standards of the educational institution.

8 M.A. & M.Com. Programme

There are three Scholarship Schemes applicable for the students' securing admissions in Master's Programme for Academic Year 2025.

a) The In-house Scholarship Scheme for the graduate students from PDEU.

- 1. Eligibility criteria for the award of In-house scholarship scheme in First Semester:
 - Available to all the graduates from PDEU in the first semester of Master's Programme.
 - Minimum CPI of 7.0 in under graduate course.
 - Performance of applicant in personal interview round.
- 2. Eligibility criteria for In-House scholarship scheme from the second semester onwards:
- 3. To have earned Minimum SPI of 7.0 in Second Semester (Master's Programme), and also of 7.0 SPI in every subsequent semester of Master's Programme.
- 4. To have passed every semester examination at the first attempt besides regular attendance, disciplined and exemplary behaviour and compliance with all other norms, as prescribed by the University from time to time.
- 5. In case of a tie between two students the amount of scholarship will be equally divided.
- 6. An applicant once ineligible in any semester won't be eligible to re-apply for scholarships.
- 7. The students availing the benefit of scholarship are required to work as Teaching Assistant for 10 hours per week with the Department/Faculties during the period of scholarship.
- 8. To continue availing the scholarship scheme in second and onward semesters' the student fresh applications will be invited from all students

and then subject to their eligibility, the scholarship will be offered to the students in Merit subject to the norms.

b) The Merit cum Means Scholarship Scheme for graduates from other institutions.

- 1. Merit cum Means Scholarship Scheme: The basic eligibility criteria is the Total Annual Income (from all Sources) of the student's parents should not be exceeding Rs. 10.00 Lacs.
- 2. Two meritorious students from each stream/subject of Master's Programme are eligible for this scholarship per semester. An applicant once ineligible in any semester won't be eligible to re-apply for scholarships. No new applicant shall be allowed in between any of the program.
- 3. Eligibility criteria for the award Merit cum Means Scholarship Scheme in First Semester: Fifty (50%) of the marks secured in graduation examination and Eighty (80%) of the marks obtained in entrance examination (Online/Offline). Subjected to minimum of 65% marks (overall) would be considered for the scholarship in the first semester.
- 4. Eligibility criteria for the award of merit cum means scholarship scheme from the second semester onwards: To become eligible for the continuance of the scholarship in subsequent semesters, the students are requiring to have earned Minimum SPI of 7.0 in the 1st Semester, and also of 7.0 SPI in every subsequent semester.
- 5. To have passed every semester examination at the first attempt besides regular attendance, disciplined and exemplary behaviour and compliance with all other norms, as prescribed by the University from time to time.
- 6. In case of a tie between two students the amount of scholarship will be equally divided.
- 7. An applicant once ineligible in any semester won't be eligible to re-apply for scholarships.
- 8. No new applicant is eligible for the scholarship in between of the Master's Programme 2025 2027.
- 9. The students availing the benefit of scholarship are required to work as Teaching Assistant for 10 hours per week with the Department/Faculties during the period of scholarship.
- 10. To continue availing the scholarship scheme in second and onward semesters' the student has to apply along with the result of the previous semester in a prescribed form wherein authentic information about the parents' income and other relevant information shall have to be furnished.

c) Defence / CAPF Persons Scholarship

Defence / CAPF Persons Scholarship: 50% of waiver of tuition fees to Defence / CAPF persons taking admission in Masters programme.

9 Ph.D. Programme

The University offers financial assistance from its own resources as per its availability in the name of scholarship, who would qualify as per the norms specified below on merit basis as follows:

i) Up to first two years : Rs.25,000/- per month as research scholarship In the third year : Rs.30,000/- per month as research scholarship

Continuance of the scholarship shall subject to punctuality, discipline, good academic / research progress review.

After third year, the scholarship may continue subject to Semester wise review scrutiny by the Doctoral Committee, but not beyond the fourth year, or till the submission of the Synopsis / Thesis, whichever is earlier.

It shall be mandatory to perform the duties as Teaching Assistant for all the full time candidates availing the scholarship.

M. E. / M. Tech. qualified candidates with valid GATE score admitted to pursue Ph.D. on full time basis in the research areas of Engineering & Technology may be granted the scholarship as mentioned above on merit basis.

M. Sc. (Technology) in GeoScience (3 year full time) qualified candidates having valid GATE / NET / SLET / CSIR score admitted to pursue Ph. D. on full time basis in the research areas of Engineering & Technology may be granted the scholarships as mentioned on merit basis.

The candidates admitted to pursue Ph.D. on full time basis in the research areas of Management may be granted the scholarships as mentioned above on merit basis provided they have valid CAT score with a minimum of 75 percentile at the time of the admission tests or a valid UGC NET / CSIR-UGC NET / SLET/ GATE score.

The candidates admitted to pursue Ph.D. on full time basis in the research areas of Sciences and areas under School of Liberal Studies may be granted the scholarships as mentioned above on merit basis provided they have a valid UGC NET / CSIR-UGC NET / SLET/ GATE score at the time of the admission tests.

Maximum 2 no. of such scholarships are allotted in every Department of Engineering, 2 for every department of SLS, and 2 for SoM.

No other Financial Assistance / Aid will be given to all such students.

The continuance of the Research scholarship shall be subjected to the six monthly academic review, discipline and punctuality of the candidate.

The above policy-procedure is subject to modification whenever found necessary by the University.

- ii) A financial assistance in the form of a Teaching Assistance (T.A.) ship on merit basis is also available for the students who would not be receiving above referred financial assistance: Rs.10,000/- per month.
 - Maximum 2 no. of T. A. ship are allotted in each department of engineering, 2 for each department of SLS, and 2 for SoM.
- iii) A financial assistance as sustenance allowance of Rs.6,000/- per month for those who would not be receiving any financial assistance from the above referred categories I & II, or from any other source.
- iv) Scholarship for Defence / CAPF Persons

A candidate will apply in normal category as well as in Defence/CAPF category. There would be no change in the eligibility criteria for admission as described in section-3 of this document.

- 100% tuition fee waiver to wards of Gallantry Award winner or those who
 made supreme sacrifice for the nation i.e. fatal battle causality. Candidate
 has to present proof of award from respective organization.
- 50% tuition fee waiver to the ward of war injured / war disabled soldier of defence force and CAPF. Candidate has to present war disability certificate from respective organization.
- 50% tuition fee waiver to the wards soldiers whose annual income less than 8.0 lakhs. Candidate has to present income certificate.
- 50% tuition fee waiver to the soldiers taking admission.

This T. A. ship may be continued up to 3 years on satisfactory performance based on overall review from semester to semester. During these 3 years such students may be given financial incentive of Rs.2,000/- per publication in approved peer reviewed journals.

The continuance of the financial assistance / T. A. ship shall be subjected to the six monthly academic review and recommendation of the doctoral committee, discipline and punctuality of the candidate.

Contingency allowance of maximum Rs.10,000/- per year as per the norms. No other Financial Assistance / Aid will be given to all such students.

Other Conditions:

i) The Research Scholar will have to assist the University / School / Department in its academic work, including tutorials, assignments, laboratory demonstration, supervision of fieldwork, library activities, group seminars, workshops, symposia, etc. from time to time. The total time to be spent on such activities

will be around ten hours a week.

- ii) The grant of the scholarship is subject to the condition that the student does not receive any financial assistance in shape of scholarship / any emoluments, salary, stipend etc. from any other source during his / her course of study at the Institute.
- iii) Foreign students and sponsored candidates are not eligible for the scholarship.
- iv) It will be obligatory on the part of every full time Ph. D. student to undertake around ten hours a week of work related to academic & co-academic and research activities as assigned to him / her from time to time. This include tutorials, laboratory classes, development and maintenance of laboratories, assistance in research and activities undertaken by faculty members, maintenance and operation of computer and other central facilities, assistance in library, examinations, etc.
- v) The scholarship will be granted to the student on a monthly basis subject to the satisfactory academic performance and adherence to the University / Institute norms / rules and regulations as applicable time to time, certified by the Supervisor, HoD, Dean, School Director and obligatory work as assigned.
- vi) The student shall be required to give an undertaking to the effect that he / she would not leave the programme midway. In case any student leaves the course in midway he / she will be required to refund the total amount of the financial assistance drawn so far, at the time of leaving the programme.

Cancellation of Financial Assistance:

The financial assistance is liable to cancellation, in case of misconduct / indiscipline / unsatisfactory progress of research work / failure in any examination related to Ph.D. or he / she is found ineligible later.
