

## **ADMISSION POLICY 2026-27**

### **School of Law**

The School of Law, a constituent institution of PDEU (formerly PDPU), is established in 2025 with a vision to nurture future-ready legal professionals. It offers two flagship Programmes — the B.A., LL.B. (5-Year Integrated Programme) and the LL.B. (3-Year Programme) — each designed to foster academic excellence, legal acumen, and professional ethics.

The B.A., LL.B. Programme provides students with a strong foundation in law alongside a multidisciplinary perspective. Emphasis is placed on building communication, analytical, and critical thinking skills, including techno-based legal education, essential for success in the legal field, while encouraging holistic development through interdisciplinary learning.

The LL.B. Programme adopts a practice-oriented curriculum that bridges academic learning with the demands of the legal profession. The Programme integrates legal theory with real-world exposure through courtroom simulations, internships, and legal clinics, thereby preparing students for a dynamic legal career.

With a commitment to producing competent, socially conscious, and globally aware legal professionals, the School of Law focuses on experiential learning through moot courts, legal aid initiatives, and hands-on training. The School aspires to shape legal minds capable of contributing meaningfully to society, public policy, governance, and international legal discourse.

Also, the objectives of both these programmes are justice oriented and to practically inculcate constitutional values and a sense of socio-economic and political justice, and to prepare students to become an instrumental to boost the justice delivery system and to make them instrumental in national reconstruction adhering democracy, rule of law and human rights.

## PROGRAMME AND PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

### 1. Programmes Offered:

#### 1.1 B.A. LL.B (5 Years Integrated)

All candidates admitted to the Programme shall be required to pursue the prescribed curriculum as determined by the University from time to time. The curriculum is designed to provide comprehensive exposure to the foundational domains of legal education.

Subjects covered under the Programme shall include, but are not limited to: English Communication, Indian History and Political System, Indian Constitution, Legal Methods, Computer Education, Legal History, Business Law, Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Bharatiya Sakshya Adhinyam, 2023, Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, Mediation, Public Administration, Law and Governance, International Relations, Environmental Law, Family Law, Jurisprudence, Civil Procedure Code and Law of Limitation, Intellectual Property Rights, Human Rights and Arbitration, Property Law, Labour Law, Forensic Psychology, Media Law, Digital Crime, Foreign Language, etc.

In addition, practical learning components such as Moot Court Exercises and Internships are embedded within the curriculum to foster critical legal reasoning, research skills, procedural understanding, and courtroom advocacy.

The aforementioned subjects aim to ensure a holistic understanding of legal principles and their practical applications within diverse socio-political and global contexts. #### 1.2 LL. B (3 Years)

All candidates admitted to the Programme shall pursue a **curriculum** structured to provide a robust foundation in core areas of legal practice. The academic framework is designed to promote a **practice-oriented approach**, integrating theoretical knowledge with practical application to prepare students for real-world legal challenges.

Under this approach, students shall gain in-depth exposure to key areas of law, including but not limited to: Law of Contract, Law of Torts, Special Contracts, Criminal Law, Constitutional Law, Property Law, Administrative Law, Family Law, and Banking Law, Computer Education, Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Bharatiya Sakshya Adhinyam, 2023, Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, Mediation.

In addition, practical learning components such as Moot Court Exercises and Internships are embedded within the curriculum to foster critical legal reasoning, research skills, procedural understanding, and courtroom advocacy.

The practice-driven pedagogy aims to ensure that graduates emerge not only with academic proficiency but also with the requisite skills and competencies expected in the legal profession.

**2. Eligibility Criteria:****2.1 B.A., LL.B (5-Year Integrated Programme)**

**2.1.1** Candidates seeking admission to the B.A., LL.B. (Five-Year Integrated Programme) must have successfully passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) examination or an equivalent qualification from any recognized board or institution, regardless of academic stream.

**2.1.2** The candidate must have studied English as one of the subjects and must have passed any one of the following qualifying examinations:

- a) The +2 level examination in the 10+2 system conducted by any recognized Central or State Board of Secondary Education, including the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi, and the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE), New Delhi.
- b) Intermediate Science or Two-Year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized Board or University.
- c) Final Examination of the Two-Year Course of the Joint Services Wing of the National Defense Academy (NDA).
- d) General Certificate of Education (GCE) Examination at the Advanced Level (London / Cambridge / Sri Lanka), with a minimum of two or three subject passes.
- e) High School Certificate Examination of the University of Cambridge.
- f) International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme, with a minimum of six subjects (three at Higher Level and three at Standard Level), and a total of 24 points.
- g) Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) with a minimum of five subjects.
- h) Higher Secondary Certificate (H.S.C.) – Vocational Stream Examination.
- i) Any Public School, Board, or University Examination in India or abroad which has been recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as equivalent to the 10+2 system.

**2.1.3** The All India Merit Rank of Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) 2026 is required for the admission. Those applying without CLAT, must pass SOLLANCE – the SOL Law Admission Common Exam - 2026.

**2.1.4 Age Limit (as per Bar Council of India guidelines):**

There is no age bar for the enrollment to the B.A., LL.B. (5 Years) Program, however it is subject to the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and regulation of the Bar Council of India.

## 2.2 LL.B. (3 Years) Programme

- a) The applicant must hold a Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a University duly recognized by the Government of India or by a competent authority in the case of foreign institutions.
- b) Candidates belonging to the General Category are required to have secured a minimum of 45% aggregate marks or an equivalent grade in their qualifying Bachelor's Degree.
- c) Candidates belonging to the Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), or Persons with Disabilities (PWD) categories shall be considered eligible upon securing a minimum of 40% aggregate marks or equivalent in their Bachelor's Degree, in accordance with applicable statutory provisions.
- d) Non-Resident Indian (NRI) candidates or foreign nationals are required to submit an affidavit confirming NRI status and must obtain an Equivalence Certificate from the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) certifying the parity of their qualifying degree with an Indian Bachelor's Degree.
- e) All applicants are required to participate in an online interview process. Admission will be granted based on merit determined through performance in the interview and academic scores. The interview panel holds the discretion to reject any applicant deemed unsuitable. Final admission authority rests with the University management.

## 2.3 Age Limit

There is no age bar for the enrollment to the B.A., LL.B. and LL.B. Programmes, however it is subject to the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and regulation of the Bar Council of India.

### **Note:**

- Admission at School of Law will be offered solely on merit.
- The University reserves the right to revise, amend, or alter the admission eligibility criteria at its sole discretion, subject to applicable regulatory norms.

## 3. Undertaking

In accordance with Rule 28 of the Bar Council of India Legal Education Rules, 2008 (as amended in 2015), candidates who do not meet the prescribed age criteria may be granted *conditional admission*, subject to the submission of a standard undertaking or affidavit. The format of such undertaking shall be framed in line with the practice followed by other recognized universities and must be duly signed by the concerned candidate.

For both the LL.B. (3 Years) and B.A., LL.B. (5 Years) Programmes, all candidates shall be mandatorily required to submit an undertaking declaring the following, prior to the issuance of the final marksheet and degree:

1. Disclosure of any existing or past criminal background,
2. Declaration regarding non-enrolment in any simultaneous degree Programme,
3. Declaration of current employment status, and
4. Compliance with the minimum attendance requirements as prescribed by the University.

**Note:** The minimum educational qualifications for eligibility shall be governed by the criteria specified on the official website of the Bar Council of India: <https://www.barcouncilofindia.org/info/educationa-de7va7>

## **4. Reservation**

### **4.1 Statutory Reservation Quota:**

The University shall adhere to the Government of India's policy on reservation in admissions. The following quotas shall be applicable:

- Scheduled Tribe (ST): 7.5%
- Scheduled Caste (SC): 15%

Candidates seeking admission under the SC/ST category must produce a valid caste certificate issued by the competent authority, accompanied by an official translation in English or Hindi, where the original certificate is not in either of the two languages

### **4.2 Physically Challenged (PwD) Quota:**

**4.2.1** A horizontal reservation of 3% shall be applicable for candidates with physical disabilities, within each category.

**4.2.2** The term "Physically Challenged" refers to a person having not less than 40% of a certified disability, as per a valid certificate issued by a duly authorized medical board or competent authority. Candidates with a disability of less than 40% are not eligible under this quota.

**4.2.3** Candidates admitted under this category shall be subject to all academic norms and requirements as applicable to other students.

**4.2.4** The disability certificate must be presented with an official translation in English, Hindi, or Gujarati. The final acceptance of the certificate shall be subject to physical verification by the Medical Officer appointed by the University.

### **4.3 Female (Girls) Quota:**

Fifty percent (50%) of the total intake shall be reserved for female candidates. In the event of non-availability of eligible candidates under this quota, the remaining seats shall be transferred to the general pool and allocated to other eligible candidates (irrespective of gender), strictly in order of merit.

#### **4.4 Defense / Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF) Quota:**

This reservation is extended to wards of serving or retired personnel of the Indian Defense Services and CAPF.

**4.4.1** A total of 15 (fifteen) supernumerary seats shall be provisioned under this quota, without any alteration to the standard eligibility criteria set forth under Clause 2 of this document.

**4.4.2** Candidates admitted under this category shall be required to meet all academic criteria and attendance norms as applicable to general candidates.

**4.4.3** For wards of serving personnel, an undertaking signed by the parent's commanding officer (in the prescribed format available on the University website) must be submitted. For wards of retired personnel, a copy of the parent's service or discharge book must be uploaded. Original documents must be presented during physical verification at the time of admission

#### **4.5 Conversion of Vacant Reserved Seats**

In the event that seats remain unfilled under any of the aforementioned reserved categories, such seats shall be transferred to the General Category, subject to the discretion of the University and in accordance with merit.

#### **4.6 NRI / NRI-Sponsored Quota:**

Fifteen percent (15%) of the total intake shall be reserved under the NRI and NRI-Sponsored categories.

**4.6.1** Eligibility under NRI Quota: Candidates who have completed their Class XII (or equivalent) education from a school located outside India or who are Non-Resident Indians (NRIs) are eligible under this category. Such candidates will be given priority in the merit list and shall be eligible for admission only under the NRI quota. Once admitted under this category, such candidates shall not be permitted to seek transfer to the General Category.

**4.6.2** Eligibility under NRI-Sponsored Quota: Candidates who are Indian citizens and have completed their Class XII (or equivalent) education from a school within India are eligible to apply under this category, provided they are sponsored by an NRI. Admissions under the NRI-Sponsored category shall be granted on the basis of merit and only after all eligible NRI candidates have been considered.

**4.6.3** Candidates applying under the NRI/NRI-Sponsored quota must indicate their category (Yes/No) at the time of filling the online application form. They must also furnish a legal affidavit from the sponsoring NRI, in the prescribed format available on the University website. Failure to submit the affidavit shall result in cancellation of the admission without any refund of fees.

**4.6.4** Vacant seats in the NRI/NRI-Sponsored category shall first be offered to candidates in the same category on a first-come-first-serve basis. Any further unfilled seats may be transferred to the General Category at the sole discretion of the Admission Committee.

**4.6.5** University's Discretion: The University reserves the right to convert or reallocate any vacant or unfilled seats across categories as it may deem appropriate, in compliance with prevailing legal and regulatory guidelines.

## **5. Online Application Process**

**5.1** All candidates seeking admission shall be required to complete the online application form available on the official website of the School of Law (SoL), PDEU. The application procedure and detailed instructions can be accessed at: <https://pdeu.ac.in/>

**5.2** For the purpose of submitting the application, candidates shall be required to pay a non-refundable application fee @ ₹1,000/-.

The payment shall be made exclusively through Internet Banking, Debit Card or Credit Card at the time of application submission.

**5.3** Candidates must upload color scanned copies of all requisite certificates and testimonials as specified in the online application form. Incomplete applications or applications without supporting documents shall be liable for rejection.

**5.4** The deadline for submission of the online application is 11:59 PM (Indian Standard Time) on 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2026. Applications submitted beyond this date and time shall not be considered under any circumstances.

## **6. Selection Process**

Unless expressly specified otherwise, all deadlines and timelines referenced in this document shall adhere to standard University office hours, i.e., between 10:00 AM and 5:30 PM (IST). For processes involving the submission of online admission forms and online transfer of fees, the applicable deadline shall be midnight (23:59 Hrs. IST) of the specified date.

The University reserves the right to modify or reschedule any published dates or timings. Any such change shall be communicated with a minimum prior notice of 12 hours through the University's official communication channels.

### **6.1 Merit Determination and Selection Procedure**

**6.1.1** All eligible applicants applying without CLAT score must appear for SOLLACE (SoL Law Admission Common Exam) followed by the personal interview as part of the admission selection process. The communication for the same shall be made

to their registered email ids.

- 6.1.2** A common merit list shall be prepared based on the composite ranking derived from the evaluation of the following components:
- English Proficiency - 10 marks
  - Legal Aptitude - 10 marks
  - Attitude & Approach - 05 marks
  - Current Affairs - 10 marks
  - Extra-curricular Activity & Achievement - 5 marks
  - 12<sup>th</sup> Result / UG Result - 10 marks
- 6.1.3** The merit list shall be prepared based on the comprehensive evaluation of the Admission Process, as determined by the University. The cut-off scores, if applicable, shall be fixed at the sole discretion of the Admission Committee. The Programme preferences indicated by the candidate in the application form shall be duly considered at the time of seat allocation.
- 6.1.4** The waitlist shall be operated, if necessary, based on the availability of vacant seats in the respective Programme, subject to the discretion of the Admission Committee and on conditions as applied at the time of admission.
- 6.1.5** In the event that any information or document submitted by the candidate is found to be false, fabricated, or misleading at any stage of the admission process or thereafter, the admission of such candidate shall be immediately cancelled. Further, the candidate shall be debarred from seeking admission to any academic Programme offered by this University for a period of two (2) years from the date of such cancellation.
- 6.1.6** All official communications regarding the admission process shall be sent exclusively through the official email ID of the School of Law. Only such communications shall be treated as final and binding. Candidates are strictly advised to check their registered email id regularly for updates, announcements, and instructions pertaining to the admission process. The University shall not be held responsible for any loss of opportunity due to non-compliance in this regard.
- 6.1.7** In the event that the University, due to administrative or other justifiable reasons, cancels the allotment of a seat already offered to a candidate, the candidate shall be entitled to a refund of the entire amount of fees paid, excluding the application form fee and processing charges, which shall be non-refundable under all circumstances.
- 6.1.8** Upon confirmation of admission, candidates shall be required to submit self-attested copies of the following documents for verification purposes:
- a) Aadhar Card (optional) / AAPAR ID
  - b) Certificate of Date of Birth,
  - c) Mark Sheet and Certificate of the 12<sup>th</sup> Standard Examination,
  - d) School Leaving Certificate,

- e) NRI Sponsorship Affidavit (in case of admission under the NRI / NRI-Sponsored Quota),
- f) Caste Certificate (SC / ST) or Disability Certificate (for Physically Challenged candidates), issued by a competent authority.

**6.1.9** The University does not collect or retain any original documents from the candidates under any circumstances. All verification shall be conducted based on the submitted copies, and candidates are advised to retain the originals for future reference and physical verification, if required.

**6.1.10** The Management shall have the authority to cancel any admission that may have been granted inadvertently, or where the admission has been obtained by the candidate on the basis of incorrect, false, misleading, or insufficient information. Such cancellation may be effected at any stage of the admission process or thereafter, upon discovery of such discrepancy.

## 7. Uniform

## 9. Payment Schedule and Modes

**9.1 Provisional Admission:** The candidate shall be required to remit the entire First Semester Fee in full as a mandatory condition for confirmation of Provisional Admission.

**9.2 Payment of Remaining Charges:** All other applicable charges, including but not limited to hostel accommodation, mess services, and energy consumption for the academic year, shall be payable in full on or before the prescribed due date as communicated by the University.

**9.3 Semester-wise Fee Payment:** Fees for each ensuing semester must be paid in full at least seven (7) days prior to the commencement of the said semester. Any delay in payment shall attract penalties as per the rules and regulations of the University.

### 9.4 Modes of Payment:

**9.4.1** All fee payments shall be made strictly via online payment modes as enabled by the University's payment gateway or designated banking channels.

**9.4.2** Cash transactions shall not be accepted under any circumstances.

**9.5 Education Loan Facility:** Eligible candidates may avail of educational loan facilities from reputed banks, subject to their respective terms and conditions. Such loans may be extended at concessional interest rates upon submission of the requisite documents, as may be prescribed by the concerned financial institution.

## 10. Admission Cancellation and Refund Policy

### 10.1 General Conditions for Cancellation and Refund:

- 10.1.1** Admission granted erroneously or on the basis of incorrect / incomplete information is liable to be cancelled at any stage. In such cases, the entire fee (excluding the application fee) shall be refunded.
- 10.1.2** Candidates who do not successfully pass the Class XII (or equivalent) Examination shall be deemed ineligible for admission, and their provisional registration shall automatically stand cancelled.
- 10.1.3** All Provisional Admissions are subject to verification and confirmation of eligibility upon declaration of results. Failure to meet the prescribed eligibility criteria shall result in automatic cancellation of admission.
- 10.1.4** Candidates are expected to maintain decorum and discipline in all academic, co-curricular, and extra-curricular activities. Any breach thereof may result in termination of admission by the competent authority.
- 10.1.5** Requests for cancellation of admission must be submitted in writing using the prescribed form, duly signed by the candidate and their parent/guardian.
- 10.1.6** All cancellation or withdrawal requests must be submitted via email to **LawAdmission@pdpu.ac.in**, and the applicable refund shall be processed in accordance with the UGC Guidelines and the Bar Council of India Rules under the Legal Education Rules, 2008.

### 10.3 Submission of Documents for Refund:

To initiate the refund process, the candidate must submit the following documents:

- Original Fee Receipt
- Admission Letter
- Duly signed Cancellation Request
- No Objection Certificate (NOC) from concerned University Departments (if cancellation is requested post commencement of the academic session)

## **11. Scholarship Schemes and related Admission Provisions**

### **11.1 Merit-cum-Means Scholarship (Total Number of Scholarships - 6):**

Eligible candidates shall be granted a 50% waiver of tuition fees, subject to the following criteria:

- a) Eligibility criteria: Based on SoL admission test merit rank and subject to minimum 80% marks obtained in 12<sup>th</sup> board examination and family income not more than 10 Lakh per annum in the previous financial year.
- b) The same student would carry the scholarship in succeeding semesters if the SPI/CPI does not go below 8/10 and the student does not have any backlog or disciplinary actions on her/him.

### **11.2 Merit-Based Scholarship (Total Number of Scholarships - 6):**

Eligible candidates shall be granted a 50% waiver of tuition fees, subject to the following criteria:

- a) Selection shall be based on the candidate's merit rank in CLAT or SOLLACE (SoL Law Admission Common Exam).
- b) A minimum of 80% aggregate marks in the Class XII Board Examination.
- c) The same student would be eligible for scholarship based on his/her SPI in succeeding semesters and also the student should not have any backlog or disciplinary actions taken on her/him.

### **11.3 Sports Scholarship (Total Number of Scholarships - 1):**

Eligible candidates shall receive a 40% waiver of tuition fees, subject to the following criteria:

- a) Eligibility criteria: Based on an excellent track record in sports at the national / international level at the entry point, duly validated with documents of achievements and then in the succeeding semester minimum participation in 3 National / international competitions.

### **11.4 Defense / CAPF Quota Scholarship:**

In honour of the service and sacrifice rendered by personnel of the Defense Forces and Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF), the following scholarships shall be available:

- a) 100% tuition fee waiver for wards of Gallantry Awardees or martyrs (fatal battle casualty), upon submission of documentary proof from the respective authority.
- b) 50% tuition fee waiver for wards of war-injured / war-disabled Defense or CAPF personnel, upon submission of relevant war injury / disability certificate.
- c) 50% tuition fee waiver for wards of serving or retired personnel of Defense or CAPF with an annual family income of less than ₹ 10,00,000, upon submission of an income certificate.

**Conditions Applicable to All Scholarships:**

- Scholarships shall be awarded only to candidates who have not availed of financial assistance under any other scheme of the Central / State Government / Private Organisations.
- Candidates must maintain conduct in accordance with the moral and disciplinary standards of the University.

**12. Hostel Accommodation and Mess Facilities**

Hostel accommodation is limited and shall be allotted on a merit basis with preference to outstation candidates.

**12.1 Hostel Fees for Academic Year 2026-27**

- a) Hostel Fees - ₹ 1,10,000 (utilities charged separately)
- b) Refundable Deposit - ₹ 5,000 (payable upon confirmation)
- c) Electricity Charges: As per actual consumption

**12.2 Mess Charges for Academic Year 2026-27**

- a) Hostel residents: ₹ 62,000 (non- refundable) for breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snacks
- b) Day scholars: ₹ 35,500 (non-refundable) for breakfast, lunch, and snacks (Monday to Friday)
