CO2 Capture Technology Demonstration -

The Center for Research on Carbon Dioxide (CRC) at PDEU, led by Professor Sukanta Dash from the Department of Chemical Engineering, focuses on carbon capture and the development of novel CO₂ capture fluids. The center operates two pilot plants, one based on absorption and regeneration columns and the other based on rotating packed bed columns, with a capacity of 1 ton per day each.

During the Tesseract event, students had the opportunity to witness engineering demonstrations of the pilot plant operations. Professor Dash provided an explanation of the CO₂ capture process, benefiting students seeking knowledge on carbon dioxide. Participants also had the chance to observe the machinery and plants where researchers were actively working. Overall, this event offered valuable industry-level exposure to ongoing international projects.

Tess-Fair -

Tess fair by Science and technical committee had various clubs organise different events and games like:

Apogee3 organised an event where participants can experience the virtual reality of space by paying an entry fee of 10 rupees.
