

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




Que-5: Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers






Que-8: The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.







Que-12: The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications












Que-17: Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.


Que-18: Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.
