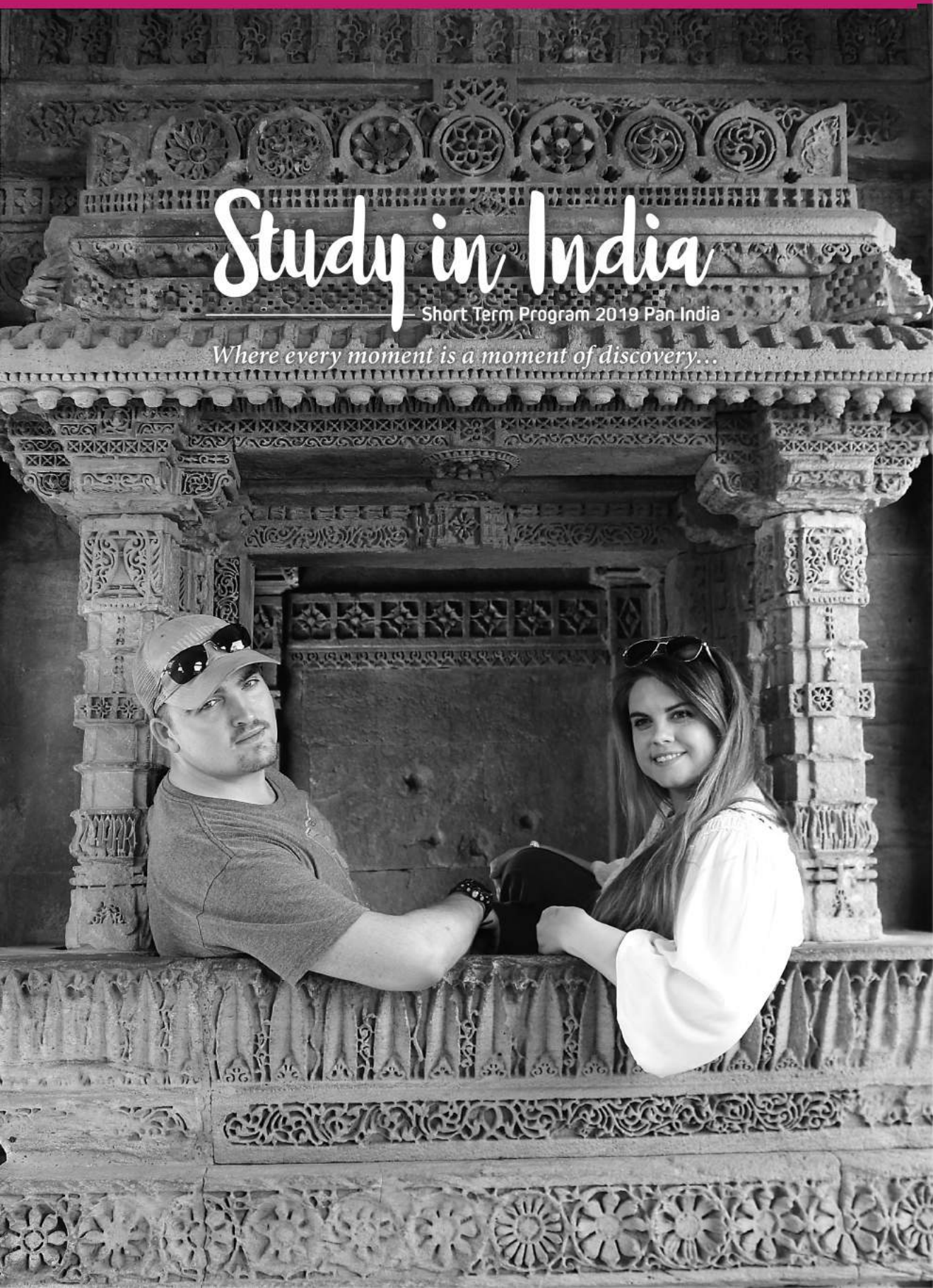

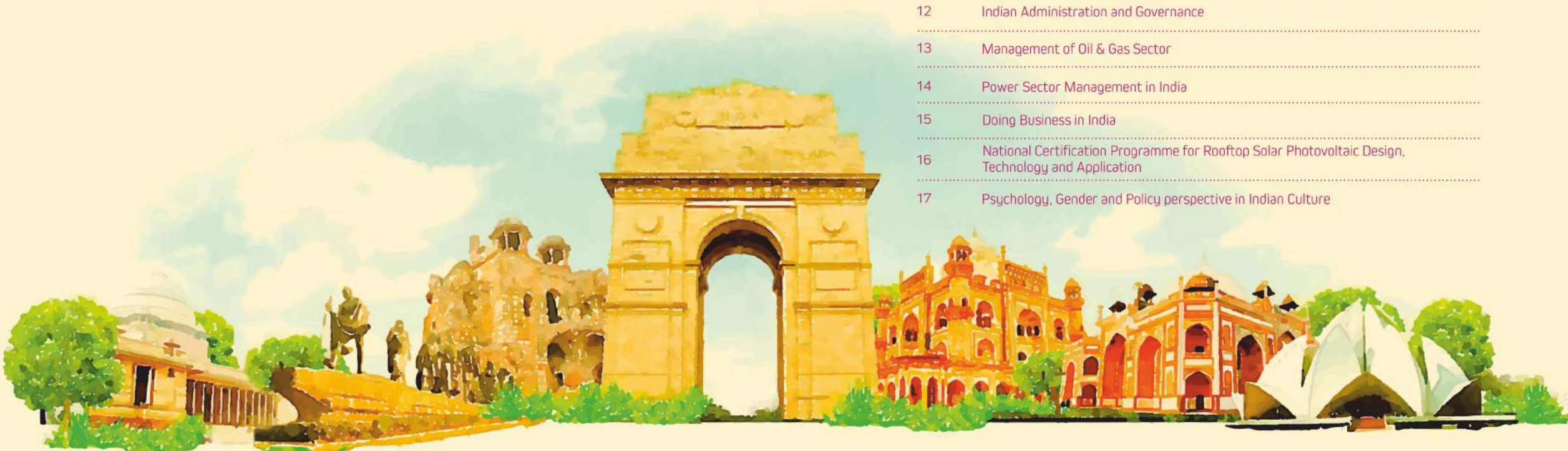
Study in India

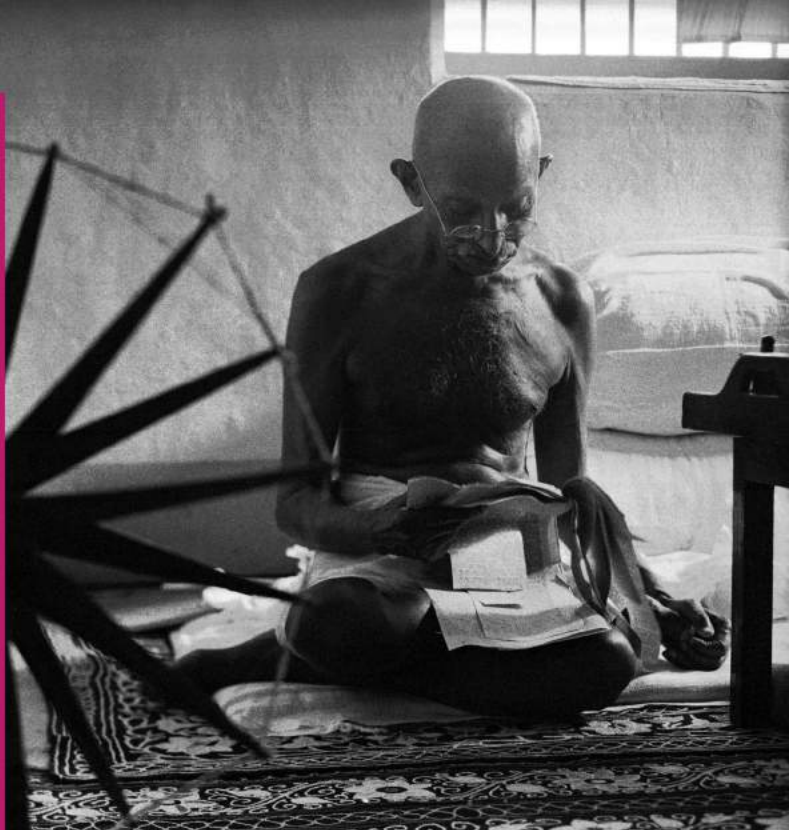

Objective of the Course

To give the participants of the course a glimpse of India's socio-cultural diversity and journey towards becoming a modern society; To acquaint the participants with the concepts of conflict and nonviolence; To give them theoretical inputs to the aspects of conflict and nonviolence that they might be interested in; To give them exposure to conflict areas (zones) through field trips to study how conflict is being managed, resolved and transformed in the Gandhian article of nonviolence.

Brief description of course

India has emerged as an economy to be taken seriously worldwide. Despite its pacifist worldview in the ancient and medieval times and "Non-aligned" foreign policy since independence, it always enjoyed geopolitical importance. Developing countries always looked up to India to speak for them at various global fora, something India has done remarkably well while following Gandhian-Nehruvian ideals. Its economy, among the largest in the world until around the 19th century, is rising from the pits it was pushed into and developed countries, too, are looking at it as a significant driver of global economy. Add to it the mystical charm India has commanded for ages and you have a heady concoction, potent enough to attract scholars, researchers and university students whose area of interest may include managing conflict that is often part of the parcel called transition. The conflict could be at individual, social, regional, national and international levels. In the first half of the 20th century Gandhi showed to the world a remarkable way to resolve conflict. The political Gandhi and his ideals continue to amuse people interested in peaceful co-existence. This course is mainly primed for the last four levels -- societal, regional, national and international -- and help the participants find solutions to existing and potential problems using Gandhian technique of nonviolence.

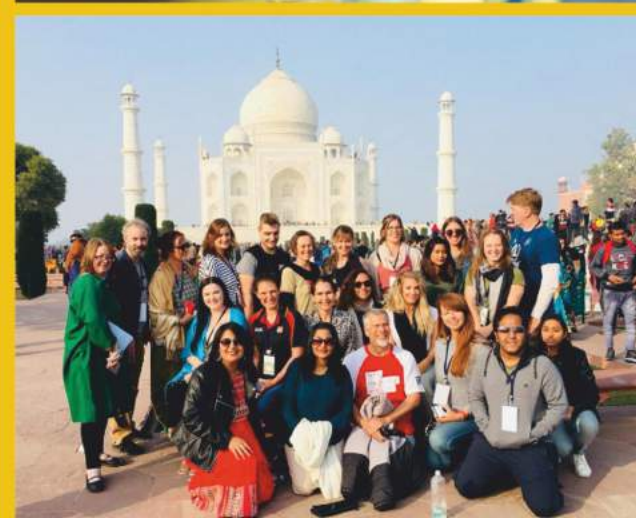

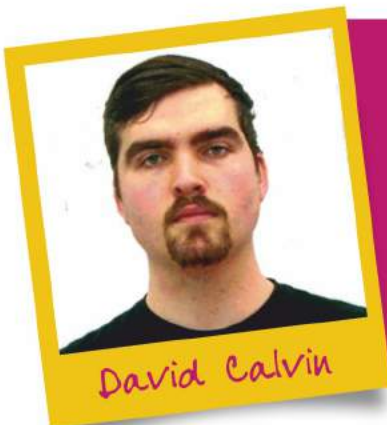
Program: Engineering Management from Indian Perspective

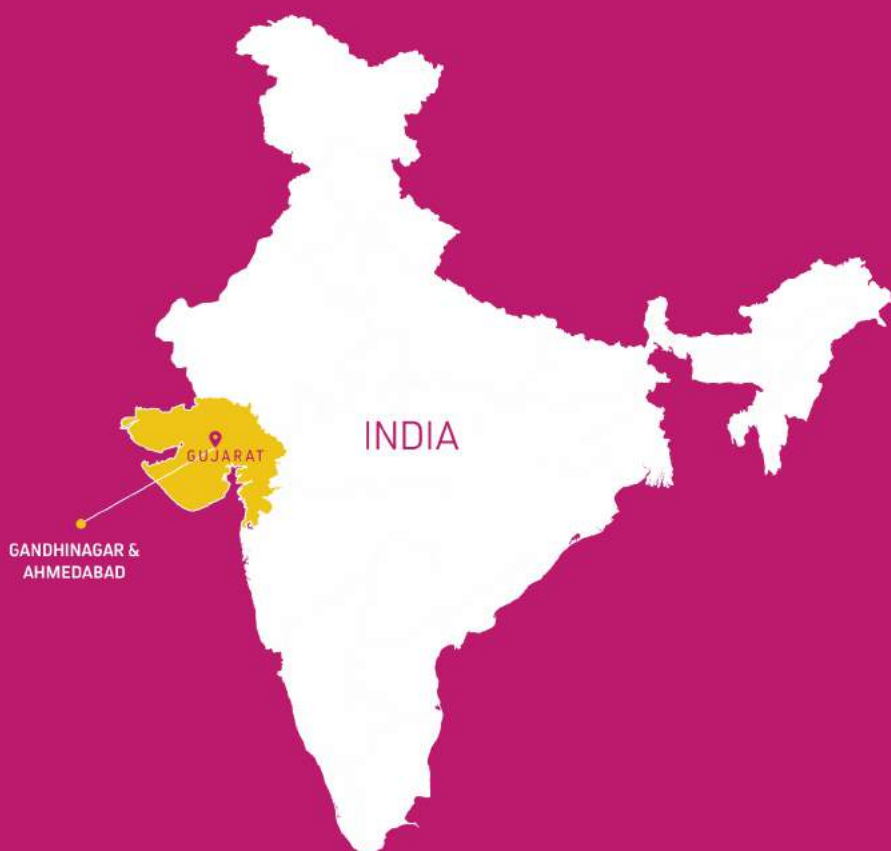
